

## Glogster Option

A Glog is a digital poster that is an excellent way to demonstrate, teach, and excite people about something related to science. A good Glog is constructed in a logical and user friendly way; it uses several different forms of media such as graphics, text, audio and video to convey information, and is fun to use.

**Requirements for Glogster Option:** Student must have the following.

- Full-time computer use with internet access (high speed recommended)
  - Glogster EDU account (free at edu.glogster.com)
1. Choose a science topic that is of interest to you.
  2. Research your topic to learn more about it. List your sources in bibliography.
  3. Develop a Graphic Organizer to outline and organize the pieces you will include in your Glog. You need at least 8 pieces.
  4. Begin creating/searching for your Glog pieces. A Glog can include:
    - a. Photographs (found online or - even better - take them yourself)
    - b. Text that you write yourself
    - c. Digital video (found online or - even better – created by you)
    - d. Audio recording or song (recorded by you)
    - e. A chart, graph, or drawing that you scan into the computer
  5. Create your Glog. Your final Glog should include the following:
    - Title
    - History/Description of your science concept
    - Detailed information about concept
    - Multimedia (Photos, video and audio) explaining the concept
    - Bibliography section (use text feature in Glogster)

Include at least 8 total pieces (2 text boxes, 2 photographs, 1 video, and 1 audio recording are required; the other 2 pieces are up to you)
