Creating a multimedia presentation is an excellent way to demonstrate, teach, and excite people about something of interest related to science. A good presentation will use several different media such as graphics, text, and sound to convey information. These different elements can be combined in a way that is informative, interesting, and fun to view.

Requirements for Multimedia Option: Student must have the following.

- ✳ Microsoft PhotoStory
- ✳ Jump Drive
- ✳ Microphone
- ✳ Recommend High Speed Internet

1. Choose a science topic that is of interest to you. Get it approved by your science teacher.
2. Research your topic to learn more about it. List your sources in bibliography.
3. Develop a graphic organizer/storyboard of how you want to organize and present your information.
4. Find photographs and music for your presentation (photographs can't be clip art). Write a script for your presentation.
5. Learn how to use the PhotoStory presentation program.
6. Produce your final **recorded** presentation using photographs, music and your recorded voice (from script).
